One of the most common reasons for a school not to employ a learning platform is due to a previous bad experience. That was the case with St Mary's School, Ardleigh. The Essex-based primary school's previous VLE had been "laborious," according to Sandra Wignall, their ICT Technician. Teachers at the school had subsequently been turned off - and a solution was required.
